


BTR 135 construction profile

FIRE CLASSIFICATION OF BALEXTHERM

Balextherm sandwich panels are classified as non-spreading fire products in accordance with PN-90/B-02867 and PN-B-02872:1996 norms.

Balextherm ST sandwich panels are classified in E-60 fire resistance class – it means, that the fire integrity criteria of covering made of Balextherm panels with soft polyurethane gasket in the joint, covered with carbon fibres is kept for a minimum 60 minutes.

Balextherm PLUS sandwich panels are classified in E-30 fire resistance class class – it means, that the fire integrity criteria of covering made of Balextherm panels with soft polyurethane gasket in the joint, covered with carbon fibres is kept for a minimum 30 minutes.

Balextherm D sandwich panels are classified in E-120 fire resistance class – it means, that the fire integrity criteria of covering made of Balextherm panels with soft polyurethane gasket in the joint, covered with carbon fibres is kept for a minimum 120 minutes.

TRANSPORTING AND STORING THE PANELS

Lorries with crates or trailers are basic means of transport for sandwich panels. It is possible to load long panels (up to 13 m) from both sides of the lorry.

Technical conditions for vehicles transporting sandwich panels are recommended as follows:

- crate with tarpaulin ("net curtain" type)
- crate longer than the transported panels (the panel packages should be put on the truck whole)
- transporting belts fastening the loading should be put on every support of panel packages (the strain of belts must not cause any deformations)

During unloading you should be careful not to drag one panel on top of another. Then they will not get scratched. Sandwich panels should be put on supports, not less than 250 mm above the ground. It is not advisable to store more than two packages, one on top of another.

It is recommended to keep panels in closed and well-ventilated rooms, at normal temperatures, away from fertilizers, acids, lye, salts and other corrosive substances. It is not advisable to store sheet metals without a covering. If they are kept under a canvas cover for a short time (max. two weeks) fresh air must be guaranteed. If the storage period is longer than two weeks, the sheet metals should be put in well-ventilated room and left open to bring fresh air to all the layers. Not using this recommendation may cause a discolouration of the coating called "white corrosion", and a loss of guarantee.


FIRE CLASSIFICATION OF PWS AND PWD

PWS walling panels are classified as non-spreading fire products (PN-90/B-02867).

PWS walling panels are classified in E-30 fire resistance class – it means, that the fire integrity criteria of wall made of PWS sandwich panels in not less than 30 minutes (PN-B-02851) and CEN.

PWD roofing panels are classified as non-spreading fire products (PN-B-02872).

PWD roofing panels are classified in E-30 fire resistance class – it means, that the fire integrity criteria of roofing profile made of PWD sandwich panels is not less than 30 minutes (PN-B-02851 and CEN).


Sheet metals storage

Sheet metals should be laid on rests, not less than 250 mm above the ground. It is not advisable to store more than 4 packages on top of each other, leant at an angle that the water could flow out properly. Sheet metals should be kept in closed and well-ventilated room, at normal temperatures, away from fertilizers, acids, lye, salts and other corrosive substances. It is not advisable to store sheet metals without covering them. If they are kept under a canvas cover for a short time (max. two weeks) fresh air must be guaranteed. If the storage period is longer than two weeks, the sheet metals should be put in wellventilated room and left open to bring fresh air to all the layers. Not using this recommendation may cause a discoloration of the coating called "white corrosion", and a loss of guarantee. The protective foil must be removed no later than one month from the day of production. Otherwise the foil may permanently stick to the sheet metal facing.



Unloading, carrying sheet metals.

When carrying the sheet metals, you have to make sure they are not pulled across the ground or another second sheet. They will not get scratched.





Max. length of sheet metals

The length of sheet metals is limited only by assembly requirements and transportation. Using the sheet metals longer than 6 m is not recommended due to problems while unloading, pulling up the roof or assembling.

Fixing the sheet metals


The sheet metals can be fixed with self-tapping screws for wooden or metal battens, according to the their sort. The screws should be screwed with a drill (with a clutch). While screwing make sure the pressure force is right not to scrunch the EPDM pad. EPDM pad should stick out of the edge of upper steel pad. The overlap joint and the joint of the two sheet metals is best to be made with a tight blind rivet "POP rivet".






Walking on the sheet metals

While walking on sheet metals you should step only onto the hollow wearing soft shoes, which should be cleaned (specially of metal pieces) every time before stepping on. Walking on the sheet metals should be limited to minimum.



Ventilation of roof slope

Before starting the process of assembly you should make sure that the project of roof slope ventilation is correct. The air should naturally flow from the eaves to the ridge to divert water vapour. If the ventilation is insufficient the bottom of the sheet metal may be damaged. Proper ventilation in hot weather prevents excessive warm-up of the sheet metal and indirectly rooms of the attic. Therefore the supports should be wider than 25 mm.




Roof self-measurement and assembly of the sheet metals

The roofs' structures are often very complicated, so Balex Metal recommends to have the assembly done by qualified roofers. If the structure is simple, with basic technical knowledge and after consulting on the problem with a specialist you can make the measurements and assemble the sheet metals yourself. Ready made flashings ordered from our company will be very useful. The measurement should be based on roof framing dimensions, because usually a roof structural dimensions are different from the design dimensions.


Roof slope optimisation

Balex Metal uses a computer programme to optimise the sheet metal wear. Computer optimisation allows to you to cut down the waste to a technological minimum. Therefore it is recommended to measure the roof slope in real terms.




Steel roof tile assembly


The sheet metals are laid in rows from the eaves to the ridge, starting from the right lower corner. The sheets are put on the supports and fixed with Farmer self-tapping screws (after fixing the drain pipe hooks and gutter flashings first). It is very important for the first row of sheet metals to be put at the right angle to the eaves. Changing the angle of the sheet metal is impossible, because they are profiled longwise. It is common to fix a straight board near the eaves forcing the right angle for assembly. After fixing the board, the first few sheets should be laid without screws to find a correct position, then the sheet metals assembly should start.




Arranging the screws and rivets in the steel roof tile

The screws should be located in every second wave, in every second row of the roof tile, in every wave next to the eaves and ridge and in every row of roof tiles on the fish plate edge. 7 - 8 screws are used per 1m² of the roof slope. The screws should be always put in the lower part of the wave. The joint of plates along the longer side and the fish plate edge should be fixed using tight blind rivets which are located on top of the profile. The joints of longer sides of the sheet metals cannot be screwed to the patches.







Fixing the finishing elements (flashings)

The finishing elements should be fixed using short or tight blind rivets. The distance of fastening should not be greater than 300 mm. The wind stoppers should be close to the nearest wave top.






